► NEW PROJECTS

1. Expansion of Therapy Program at the ECR Center includes significantly increasing hours of expressive and paramedical therapies, introducing a new approach – Dyadic Therapy (child and parent). In addition, special workshops to empower staff will enhance treatment.



2. Parental involvement is essential for successful treatment:

In order to encourage parental involvement workshops and seminars will be offered to parents. In addition, we emphasize co-operation between our staff and the teaching staff in schools. Meetings with teachers from local schools have been amazingly successful in the search for solutions.

3. Bridging Educational and Cultural Gaps for Ethiopian Pupils:

Thanks to a generous grant from the **Sobell Foundation**, we have been able to continue our work at the local Yavneh Elementary School with 30 immigrant Ethiopian pupils. Purpose of the project: to help children overcome language and remedial difficulties; to enhance emotional well being through expressive therapies; and to help bridge cultural gaps enabling them to adapt to Israeli society.

► PROFESSIONAL SEMINARS, WORKSHOPS AND CONVENTIONS FOR HAIFA CENTER STAFF

- The staff participated in a one day seminar on the topic of "How to Understand and Cope with ADD/ADHD" at the Rambam Hospital Medical School.
